

## **NOVEMBER 4, 2025 – NEW JERSEY ELECTION**

Tuesday, November 4, 2025 is the General Election. Voters will go to the polls to elect their Governor and State Assembly Members.

### **GOVERNOR'S RACE**

The two major party candidates running for Governor are Republican Jack Ciattarelli, who is a former NJ Assemblyman and Democrat Mikie Sherrill, who is a Member of Congress representing NJ's 11<sup>th</sup> District.

#### **Jack Ciattarelli**

##### **R – Candidate for Governor**

**The following are from Republican Candidate Jack Ciattarelli's campaign website:**

- 1) Prohibit elective abortions after 20 weeks while ensuring all women have access to high-quality prenatal care and education;
- 2) Support parental notification for minors seeking an abortion - the fact that a 16-year-old in New Jersey needs her parents' permission to get her ears pierced, but not get an abortion is absurd;
3. Oppose taxpayer funding of abortion;
4. Oppose the so-called "Reproductive Freedom Act" signed into law by Governor Murphy that allows abortion up to the moment of birth;
5. Support education and innovative approaches to reduce teenage and unwanted pregnancies.

#### **Mikie Sherrill**

##### **D-Candidate for Governor**

Mikie Sherrill has been endorsed by Planned Parenthood, and the Pro-Abortion Group, Emily's List. As a Congresswoman, she has a 100% pro-abortion voting record.

Mikie Sherrill voted against H.R. 26 on January 11, 2023. This bill establishes requirements for the degree of care a health care practitioner must provide in the case of a child born alive following an abortion or attempted abortion.

Specifically, a health care practitioner who is present must (1) exercise the same degree of care as would reasonably be provided to any other child born alive at the same gestational age, and (2) ensure the child is immediately admitted to a hospital. Additionally, a health care practitioner or other employee who has knowledge of a failure to comply with the degree-of-care requirements must immediately report such failure to law enforcement.

She is a co- sponsor of H.R. 12, The Women’s Health Protection Act, which is the federal version of the radical NJ Reproductive Freedom Act which allows abortions up to the moment of birth. It would establish a right to abortion in federal law, essentially overturning the Dobbs Decision.

She is the prime sponsor of H.R. 1742, The Access to Reproductive Care for Servicemembers Act, which would use taxpayer funds to provide abortion for military service members.

She is also a co-sponsor of H.R. 846, a bill to shut down pregnancy centers.

If elected Governor, Mikie Sherrill promises to radically promote abortion in the Garden State. It is an issue she will put front and center. She will push for an amendment to permanently enshrine the right to an abortion in New Jersey's state constitution. Governor Murphy has allocated more than \$268 million in taxpayer funds during his two terms in office. At a time when the federal government and other states are enacting laws to restrict taxpayer funding for Planned Parenthood, and when New Jersey residents are burdened with rising electric bills and struggling to make ends meet, Mike Sherrill has pledged to continue funding Planned Parenthood’s abortion business with the hard-earned money of NJ taxpayers. Mikie Sherrill also supports legislation that will pay for abortion in all health insurance plans with no co-pays, no deductibles and no co-insurance, adding to the already unaffordable cost of NJ’s health insurance premiums.
